## Who Should Be Screened?

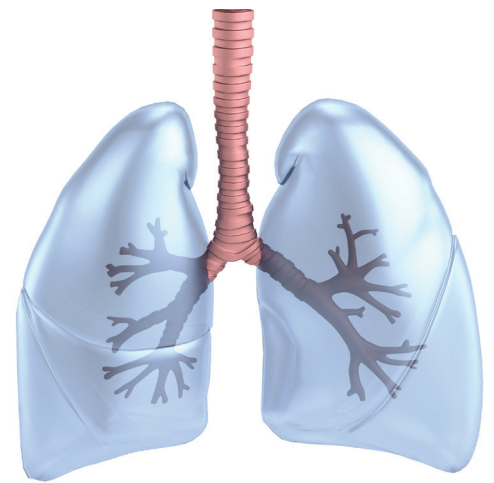
**If you are a current or former smoker, speak with your physician to discuss the risks and benefits of receiving a low dose CT scan.**

### Eligibility Criteria\*

<b>Age</b>	55 - 77 years
<b>Symptoms</b>	Asymptomatic (no signs or symptoms of lung cancer)
<b>Smoking History</b>	Current smoker or one who has quit within the last 15 years 30+ pack year smoking history (a pack a day for 30 years or more)
<b>Screening Duration</b>	Screening should be discontinued once a person has not smoked for 15 years
<b>Shared Decision Making</b>	A Lung Cancer Screening and Shared Decision Making Visit is required to determine eligibility and to receive a Low Dose Computer Tomography lung cancer screening

Must have written order from physician

\*Eligibility based on Medicare Criteria
